The NHS operating framework for 2012-2013 confirmed that all providers of NHS funded care, are expected to eliminate mixed sex accommodation, except where it is in the overall best interest of the patient.

Whilst you have been a patient on the Intensive Care Unit, the High Dependency Unit or the Post Operative Critical Care Unit, you are offered a bed in a mixed sex area due to your acute illness.

You have now been stepped down to ward level care and as such, you will go to a single sex bay on a ward.

Due to the demands for beds on the wards, it is not always possible to get a bed straight away.

Mixed sex accommodation

Whilst you are waiting for a ward bed and remain on critical care we, unfortunately, cannot guarantee that we can provide single sex accommodation and you may remain in a mixed sex bay.

Rest assured, staff will always maintain your privacy and dignity whilst you wait for a bed on the ward.
