- Sip a small glass of water every hour while waiting.
- This stops you from feeling too thirsty or dehydrated.
- It helps you feel better before and after your procedure.
- It is safe to drink these fluids. No extra risk.

#### What I can and cannot drink

- ✓ Water or squash (only these allowed)
- X No fizzy drinks, milk, or alcohol.

#### When should patients stop drinking?

When they are called for their procedure.

One third of a 500mls bottle (approx. 150mls)

## Patients who should follow 'Sip Til Send':



✓ All patients undergoing surgery unless told otherwise.

If in doubt then please ask your surgeon or anaesthetist.

#### Patients who should not drink:

- X Patients with difficulty in swallowing.
- Patients who take special medicines (like GLP-1 drugs for Diabetes or Weight) that mean no drinking is safer for you.
- Patients having an endoscopy for throat, food pipe or bowel checks.
- Patients having an X-ray of the stomach or bowel.
